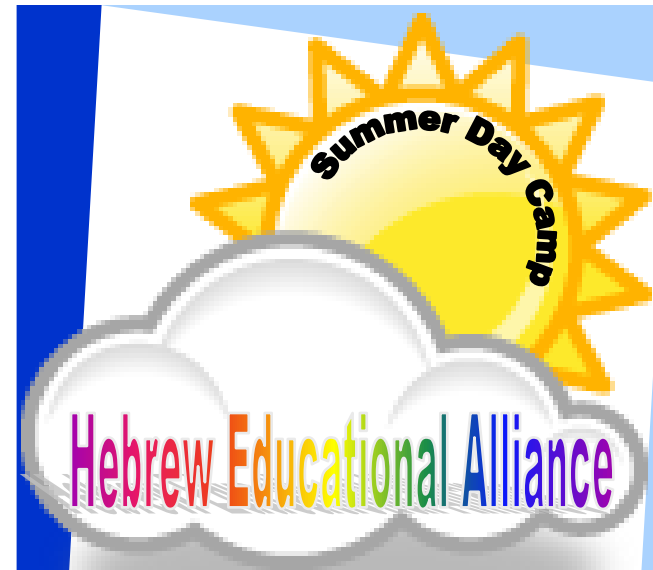

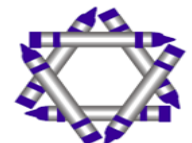

Weeks 4-6

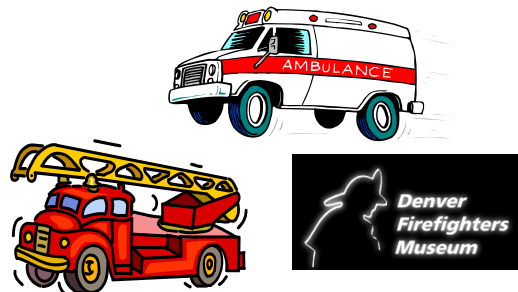
