Each Chair, a Whole World

Therefore, Adam was created alone to teach you that anyone who destroys one soul from Israel, the verse ascribes one as if one destroyed an entire world. And conversely, anyone who sustains one soul, the verse ascribes one as if one has sustained an entire world (Babylonian Talmud Sanhedrin 37a).

I'd like to dedicate this essay to the empty chairs, each one representing a life – a soldier, a hostage, a young adult dancing at a music festival, a parent whose tzitzit we used to play with between our fingers. As the Talmud teaches in Sanhedrin 37a, each chair represents an entire world, a family, a community, a collection of encounters and impacts. This year we invite into our hearts the 200 empty chairs that sit vacant in Hostage Square in Israel along with the pain and agony of their families. We invite in the hundreds of empty chairs of brave fallen soldiers and their loved ones. And we also invite and acknowledge the chairs that sit empty at our own tables. For we all have these chairs. The unifying truth of the human condition is that nobody gets through life without an empty chair.

This has been a year of many empty chairs from Israel to our own homes. Today we feel the emptiness of those vacant places beside us while we remember the precious lives that filled them. **As we begin the Yizkor service, I invite you to consider whose empty chairs are you feeling this year and how are you drawn to remember their legacy?**

Recently a congregant told me a story about active remembering that I found to be very moving. In early November of 2023, he was inspired to travel to Israel to help after the horrible attacks on October 7. He filled his carry-on luggage with the equipment and supplies that his military contacts in Israel asked him to bring, and he boarded an El Al flight to Tel Aviv. Why on earth would he book a flight to Israel just days after October 7th? Because, he explained to me, his grandfather and father had traveled to Israel following the War of Independence, the Six Day War, and the Yom Kippur war. “This was a calling,” he said.

After spending a week traveling around delivering supplies, he came to Jerusalem to assess what was next for him. While sitting on the balcony of his hotel, he suddenly witnessed two birds fluttering about who landed on the railing in front of him. The way they came so close to him, the way they sat there as if looking at him, he just knew that these were the presence of his parents. He smiled, feeling complete, and then booked a flight back to Denver, feeling the power of connection and memory, family and legacy.

May we all come to find signs of those whose absence we feel. Each sign – whether a chair, a bird, or something else -- represents a soul, and each soul represents a whole world to us. May each of their memories be for a world of blessing.

Releasing Regret

Reid Peterson, who is a grief counselor and creator of the Grief Refuge app, writes in his essay titled *Grief Related Regret*,

One of the more common words I hear from people impacted by grief is the word regret. I'm told that they have many regrets. Some are for behaviors when their special person was still living. Some are for thoughts that they continue to have, despite knowing they couldn't have done anything differently. Some are for words that were or weren't spoken to their special person when they were still alive.

Grief-related regret is an emotion that I've felt sharply at times - regret that I failed to respond to a sweet text from a loved one in the weeks before her unexpected death, regret that I didn't give a friend more attention in the year before his passing from pancreatic cancer because I was angry with him. This feeling that I messed up and can't go back in time to fix my mistake while my loved-one is still living - it hurts deep in my chest. Maybe this is a feeling you can relate to.

Several of the phrases that we Jews traditionally say to mourners involve words with the root nun chet mem, including “*Hamakom yinachem etchem b'toch she-ar avelei Tzion v'Yerushalayim*” - may God comfort you amongst all the mourners of Zion and Jerusalem. The Hebrew root *nun chet mem* forms the basis of words that mean to be sorry, grieve, regret, reconsider, repent, comfort, console, and take vengeance or revenge (source: <https://halakhah.com/rst/shoroshim.pdf>). And the single word *hitnachamut* means both regret and consolation.

How can we move from grief-related regret to consolation? Peterson offers several strategies, including addressing self-forgiveness as a choice instead of an emotion, reframing the facts to remember that we made the best decision we could have given the circumstances and information that we had, and apologizing to the loved-ones that we have lost, either out loud, through letters or through our thoughts.

Maybe these strategies will be helpful. I plan to try the apology strategy first. But none of these strategies is guaranteed to eliminate our grief-related regret. There are no perfect words we can utter or hear that will take away our pain or self-blame. In the absence of a sure path from regret to consolation, I hope as we begin Yizkor today that we can at least practice what Rabbi Sharon Brous calls “bearing with-ness” - drawing near and being present with each other even when we don't know the right thing to say. I care about you, I see the reflection of the divine in you, and I want us to be present with each other in our grief.

INTRODUCTION. Yizkor is a time set aside to formally include in our thoughts and prayers family and friends who have passed away. In reciting Yizkor, the veil between the worlds of the living and the dead becomes more transparent. For some, memories of family and friends evoked by the festival add to our sense of fullness and peace. For some, those memories bring sadness at the loss of those we loved. For still others, these memories may be disquieting. Whatever our circumstances, as we travel through the cycle of the year, the people who were once with us in person travel with us in spirit.

The opening to a heavenly world, which Yizkor evokes, is symbolized by holding a Torah during the service and our standing as we recite the prayers recalling those who have died. Some communities begin doing so as these opening meditations are recited; some do so when the personal prayers for the departed are recited (page 335).

service was called *seder
matnat yad*, the service of
expressing generosity on
behalf of those who have
died. That name comes
from the closing line of the
Torah reading for the final
day of the pilgrimage festi-
vals: “Every person giving a
gift according to the bless-
ing they have received from
Adonai” (Deuteronomy
16:17). Offering charitable
gifts and performing acts
of justice, love, and care in
memory of those who have
died provide us with ways
of honoring their memory
and continuing their influ-
ence for good.

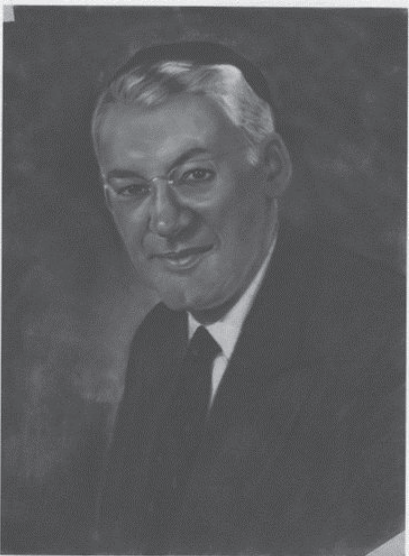
