- Enjoy lunch at Hummus Shel Tehina a bastion of delicious homestyle cooking and warm service that'll make you
 feel right at home
- Visit Sderot including a lookout over Gaza, the site of the Police Station, & Children's Playground
- Visit Kibbutz Alumim and hear from local residents about October 7th and life there since
- Travel to Tel Aviv
- Check in to hotel
- Evening & dinner on own
